IDPs supplied with food packages in Suleimaniyah

ETTC, European Technology and Training Centre, is supplying IDP families with food packages. The last campaigns of food distribution were implemented in Erbil province in different locations; Bahirka, Ankawa, Shaqlawa and other locations inside Erbil. After the crisis of the terrorist attacks in the region the IDPs numbers increased in the three big cities in Kurdistan. Therefore, ETTC is trying to widen its support campaigns to Suleimaniyah and Duhok, therefore this campaign was decided to be distributed in Suleimaniyah. The donation contained 620 Food packages for families and distributed among the IDPs families in different locations in Suleimaniyah; 438 Food packages in 4 Churches (315 families in Mar Yousef, 37 families in Evangelical, 51 families in Maryam Azraa and 35 families in Chwarchra) and 22 packages in two different IDPs Centre and 160 Food packages distributed in Arbat camp on the (Yazidian and Shabak families), the situation of the IDPs in the camp was very bad and their number was increasing every day. . Arbat is a small sub-district about 15 minutes southern Suleimaniyah, 20 km far from Suleimaniyah and day by day increasing IDPs families in Arbat especially in the camp.

Preparation and Distribution



ETTC as usual implements the food distribution process itself, means the ETTC staff purchases the foods, packing and distributing among the IDPs. In this way the quality of the service retains along with the ETTC standards and the transparency stands high as usual. After purchasing the items in the market, ETTC will transport the foods to the main ETTC building in Erbil through big trucks. Then the

items will be picked off in one of the low-temperature halls and the packing process will start. All ETTC staff members are participated in the process under a teamwork atmosphere and 620 packages have been arranged in a few hours and the packages have been loaded to the Trucks and a group of ETTC staff traveled to Suleimaniyah to distribute the packages among the IDPs in the shelters and camps.




These supports are not only a material aid, but also it is touching our hearts and lets feel that we are not forgotten by the international communities, thank you so much.

IDPs Highlighted Situation



- Since 7 September 900 IDP families have returned from the Kurdistan Region to the Al-Qosh sub-district.
- Kurdish Prime Minister Nechirvan Barzani warned, Iraq's government must "intervene immediately" to aid hundreds of thousands of war refugees who have settled in Kurdistan Region. Also said, Baghdad to get involved more and we ask the (Iraqi) prime minister to visit Duhok to see the magnitude of this humanitarian catastrophe. "Also asking the Iraqi president, Mr. Fouad Masum, to visit and closely be informed of the situation.
- The KRG told Abadi about the situation and informed him that there are more than 800,000 displaced people in the province of Dohuk, which is not able to provide aid to them. The Iraqi government must intervene immediately to save the refugees.
- According to UN data, more than a half-million refugees from Iraq and Syria have settled in Duhok province alone, making it the top recipient of the influx into Kurdistan's three provinces.
- There are approximately 31,000 students among the refugees in the province of Duhok, and schools must be built in each camp," Barzani added, urging refugee teachers in the camps to serve their people and help displaced students continue their studies.
